ABOUT THE BOARDS

INTERESTING FACT

Arizona's governor and superintendent of public instruction each serve as *ex-officio* members of the Arizona Board of Regents, along with eight gubernatorial appointees. Student regents serve two-year terms. The first year is non-voting and the second year is voting.



MEMBERSHIP

- 2 ex-officio members
- 2 student members (1 who votes)
- 0 faculty members



SELECTION

- 0 members are selected by a general election
- 10 members are selected by the governor
- 0 members are selected by the state legislature



PROCESS


There *isn't* a formalized removal process for members



REQUIREMENTS

All must be state residents
Some must live in a certain region of the state
