ABOUT THE BOARDS

INTERESTING FACT

Without a governor or state legislature, the District of Columbia's mayor, with the advice and consent of the city council, appoints eleven members to the Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia. At least seven of those members must be residents of the District; four must be non-residents.



MEMBERSHIP

- 1 student member who votes
- 0 faculty members



SELECTION

- 0 members are selected by a general election
- 0 members are selected by the mayor
- 0 members are selected by the state legislature



PROCESS


- There **is** a formalized removal process for members
- There **isn't** an external vetting process for members



REQUIREMENTS

- Seven must be District residents
- None must live in a certain region
