ABOUT THE BOARDS

INTERESTING FACT

All 15 members of the University of Hawai'i Board of Regents, including its student representative, are appointed by the governor, who also has the power to remove them at his or her own discretion. The board governs the ten University of Hawai'i campuses and six educational centers.



MEMBERSHIP

- 1 student member who votes
- 0 faculty members



SELECTION

- 0 members are selected by a general election
- 15 members are selected by the governor
- 0 members are selected by the state legislature



PROCESS

- There **is** a formalized removal process for members
- There **is** an external vetting process for members



REQUIREMENTS

- None must be state residents
- Some must live in a certain region of the state
