MEMBERSHIP

- boards have student members (2 who vote)
- 0 boards have faculty members (0 who vote)



SELECTION

- boards have members selected by a general election
- board has members selected by the governor
- board has members selected by the state legislature



PROCESS


- 2 boards have an external vetting process for members
- board has a formalized removal process for members



REQUIREMENTS

- 0 boards require some members to be state residents
- 2 boards require some members to live in a certain region of the state
